Important Information

- **Sun Cream Reminder:** As the weather gets warmer, please provide **labelled sun cream** for your child, and ensure they arrive with it already applied in the morning.
- **30 Hours Childcare Funding – September Starters**
If you think you may be eligible for the 30 hours funding from September, please ensure you apply **anytime before 31st August 2025**. Applications submitted after this date will not be valid for the September term. Speak to a member of staff if you need help with the process.
- **Label Your Child's Belongings**
To help avoid mix-ups, please ensure your child's name is clearly written on all their belongings, including water bottles, clothing, bags and lunchboxes. If items are not labelled, we will assume they belong to the nursery, and they may get mixed up.
- **Enjoy Benefits Scheme**
If you are enrolled through your employer, you may be able to use the Enjoy Benefits scheme towards your childcare costs.
- **Family Photos**
We kindly ask families to provide a photo of your child with their dad (or special person) which we'll use as part of our crafts and displays for the week. Please email or hand in your photo by **9th June**.
